*The Lesson: **Exodus 20:1-17** (for your own reading)*

And God spoke all these words:

“I am the Lord your God, who brought you out of Egypt, out of the house of slavery.

“You must have no other gods before me.

Do not make an idol for yourself – no form whatsoever - of anything in the sky above or on the earth below or in the waters under the earth. Do not bow down to them or worship them, because I, the Lord your God, am a passionate God. I punish children for their parents’ sins even to the third and fourth generations of those who hate me. But I am loyal and gracious to the thousandth generation of those who love me and keep my commandments.

Do not use the Lord your God’s name as if it were of no significance; the Lord won’t forgive anyone who uses his name that way.

Remember the Sabbath day and treat it as holy. Six days you may work and do all your tasks, but the seventh day is a Sabbath to the Lord your God. Do not do any work on it – not you, your sons or daughters, your male or female servants, your animals or the immigrant who is living with you. Because the Lord made the heavens and the earth, the sea and everything that is in them in six days but rested on the seventh day. That is why the Lord blessed the Sabbath day and made it holy.

Honor your father and your mother so that your life will be long on the fertile land that the Lord your God is giving you.

Do not kill.

Do not commit adultery.

Do not steal.

Do not testify falsely against your neighbor.

Do not desire and try to take your neighbor’s house. Do not desire and try to take your neighbor’s wife, male or female servant, ox, donkey, or anything else that belongs to your neighbor.

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*The Epistle: **I Cor. 1:18-25** (for your own reading)*

For the message of the cross is foolishness to those who are being destroyed, but it is the power of God for those of us who are being saved. For it is written in scripture:

*“I will destroy the wisdom of the wise; and I will reject the intelligence of the intelligent.”*

Where are the wise? Where are the legal experts? Where are the today’s debaters? Has not God made the wisdom of the world foolish? In God’s wisdom, he determined that the world wouldn’t come to know him through its wisdom. Instead, God was pleased to save those who believe through the foolishness of preaching. Jews asked for signs and Greeks look for wisdom, but we preach Christ crucified, which is a scandal to Jews and foolishness to Gentiles. But to those who are called – both Jews and Greeks – Christ is God’s power and God’s wisdom. This is because the foolishness of God is wiser than human wisdom and the weakness of God is stronger than human strength.

*The Gospel: John 3: 1-17 (from NIV)*

Now there was a Pharisee a man named Nicodemus who was a member of the Jewish ruling council. He came to Jesus at night and said, “Rabbi we know that you are a teacher who has come from God. For no one could perform the signs you are doing if God were not with him.”

Jesus replied, **“Very truly I tell you, no one can see the kingdom of God unless there are born again.”**

“How can someone be born when they are old?” Nicodemus asked. “Surely they cannot enter a second a time into their mother’s womb to be born!”

Jesus answered, **“Very truly I tell you, no one can enter the kingdom of God unless they are born of water and the Spirit. Flesh gives birth to flesh, but the Spirit gives birth to spirit. You should not be surprised at my saying, ‘You must be born again.’ The wind blows wherever it pleases. You hear it sound, but you cannot tell where it comes from or where it is going so it is with everyone born of the Spirit.”**

“How can this be?” Nicodemus asked. **“You are Israel’s teacher,”** said Jesus **“and do you not understand these things? Very truly I tell you, we speak of what we know,”** and we testify to what we have seen, but still you people do not accept our testimony. I have spoken to you of earthly things and you do not believe; how then will you believe if I speak of heavenly things? **No one has ever gone into heaven except the one who came from heaven – The Son of Man. Just as Moses lifted up the snake in the wilderness, so the Son of Man must be lifted up, that everyone who believes” may have eternal life in him.”**

For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life. For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through him.
